

2023 MEET HIGHLIGHTS

- Highest average daily handle on live racing ever in track's 19-year history \$830,371
- Highest average daily handle on live racing in state of New Mexico since 2010
- Five of the Top 10 all-time record Zia Park racing handles recorded in 2023, including #2 all-time on November 28 race card (\$1,988,079)
- Record eight (8) consecutive Thoroughbred racing cards of \$1 million+ total handle
- Live on-track handle up 47% from 2022 (\$42,560 average per day)
- Highest live handle (\$99,087 November 26) since 2015
- Total Year to Day Simulcast import handle up 20% over 2022
- Highest average daily overnight purse distribution in track history \$344,067
- Average total daily purse distribution was \$432,677
- Highest average per race purse in track history \$34,168
- Highest average daily overnight purse distribution in New Mexico racing history
- Thoroughbred field size of 8.91 vs 7.45 in 2022
- Lowest number of total racing catastrophic injuries in track history (2) and one (1) during training rate of 0.74 per 1000 starters
- Lowest number of Quarter Horse catastrophic injuries (1) since 2014
- Since 2020 a total of four (4) Thoroughbred catastrophic racing injuries for a rate of 0.63
