A look at where the 1% donations from the track went to help horsemen:

EVH 1 \$30,000. (hay, grain, supplies)

Covid-19 \$52,600. (direct financial assistance to many owners and trainers)

Special Donations \$157,000. (helping horsemen with hardships, financial crisis, funeral expenses,)

Miscellaneous track consultation, impact study, track samples, to name a few.

Split Test \$200,000. (NMHA doesn't pay this currently, but we still advocate for the horsemen)

Legal fees \$200,000. (owners correlation lawsuit)

Attorney fees \$373,000. (2009 HBPA legal fees, Sunray & Zia Park simulcast signal, NMHA vs NMRC)

Stall rent – Santa Fe 2016 \$82,000., Sunray 2013 \$40,000. & \$10,000., Albuquerque 2016 \$27,433.

Ruidoso Downs Flood Relief (helped jockeys replace equipment lost)

NMHA satellite offices – Sunland Park office \$18,000. – Albuquerque Downs office \$12,570.

(a place for horsemen to meet and get assistance)

NMHA also received a \$2.00 PAC fund fee:

This was used and only used to pay for donations for candidates that were running for office that support racing and the NMHA lobbyist that helps the Horsemen get bills heard and protect our industry all through legislation.
